



Professor Dr. Bostjan ANTONČIČ

Bostjan Antončič is Professor of Entrepreneurship at *University of Ljubljana*, School of Business and Economics, Ljubljana, Slovenia.

His main research interests include corporate entrepreneurship/intrapreneurship, entrepreneurial networks, entrepreneurial personality, international entrepreneurship, and creation, management and growth of small and medium-sized enterprises.

He has authored or co-authored seventeen books (fourteen of them in the area of entrepreneurship) and various scientific research articles. His papers were published in academic journals such as the *Journal of Business Venturing*, *Technovation: The International Journal of Technological Innovation and Entrepreneurship*, *Journal of Small Business Management*, *Entrepreneurship and Regional Development*, *Industrial Management and Data Systems*, *Journal of Developmental Entrepreneurship*, *Journal of Enterprising Culture*, *Economic and Business Review*, *Managing Global Transitions*, *Journal of Business Economics and Management*, *Transformations in Business and Economics*, *Journal of Management Development*, and *Journal of Small Business and Enterprise Development*.

He was a visiting scholar at various universities on three continents. He has taught courses in entrepreneurship and management, such as Entrepreneurship, New Venture Creation, Family Business, Entrepreneurial Networks, Business Ethics, and Management of Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises.

In addition to research and teaching, he has been involved in entrepreneurship (small business founder and manager, counsellor, mentor, consultant, and inventor) and sport (*World champion* in the sailing class *Soling* in 2008).
